1. Executive Summary

Dr. Dhungana is a widely recognized authority in modernizing educational assessment systems in Nepal. His work heavily focuses on aligning institutional teaching standards with global digital benchmarks.

- Train faculty members to seamlessly weave information and communication technology (ICT) into daily lesson planning.
- To give teachers new ways to test and grade students fairly, keeping in mind that different students learn at different speeds.
- Bridge the gap between individual classroom teaching methods and the national curriculum standards mandated by the MOEST.
